The additional Provisional Allowance, Task C.3, was added as a result of the recommendation to address the flood mitigation efforts, which includes raising level sensors and updating them for the Baby Creek Facility.

Provisionary Allowance is an amount included in the Contract Price to reimburse the Contractor for the cost to furnish and perform Work that is uncertain. Any remaining balance upon Final Completion shall be retained by the GLWA and not paid to the Contractor.

Benchmarking was completed by comparing the proposals for this project. This analysis confirmed that rates are in competitive range. The rate comparisons and allowances (if any) are



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illustrated in the attached cost tabulation.
