Could you give us more details on your agenda's proposed contract items?

I noticed that you're repairing one of your sampling stations. Where are your sampling stations? When are samples taken and are they automatically taken?

This last week, NPR radio stated a Doctor in the Netherlands stated the virus lives in sewage; he said the sewage could be used to monitor the prevalence of the virus in the population.

Ozonation and ultra-violet light are good at killing this and future bouts with viruses. Saulius Simoliunas, who worked for 30 years as a chemist, at both the sewage plant and water works park, told me that years ago, DWSD installed some ozonators at Water Works Park to kill internal parasites;

Unfortunately, the ozonaters were not maintained properly and quit functioning. Boston's Deer Island Japanese Ozonators are maintained by a Japanese service crew.

We should be installing activated carbon filtration and these ozonators on our water intakes as well as on our sewage discharges.

Now is the time to design, fund, and build a healthy system. We need a massive water infra-structure program and a supplemental funding source to provide this on a continuing basis. HEALTHY Water trumps roads.
