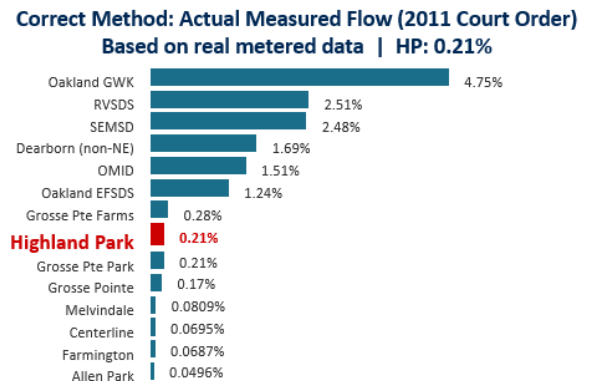
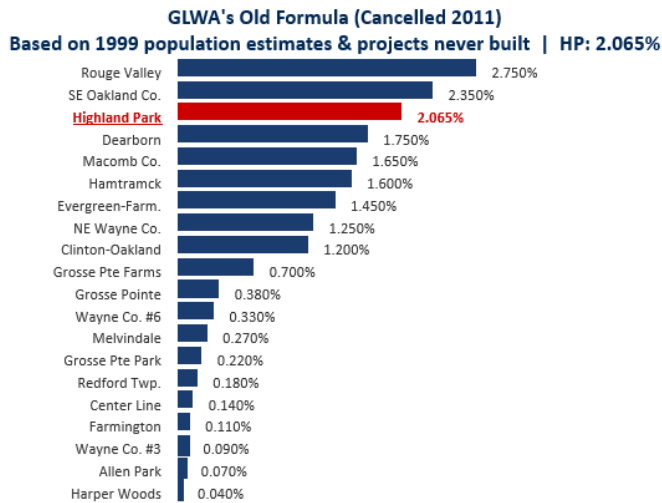

GLWA CSO Cost Pool Task Force Denial

GLWA's CSO Cost Pool Task Force Voted Unanimously to Continue Using Outdated and Inaccurate Information

Dearborn, MI – Today GLWA's CSO Cost Pool Task Force voted unanimously to continue using outdated and inaccurate CSO methodology, by ignoring state law, and not acknowledging Highland Park's best available metered CSO flow information. This vote means Highland Park will continue to be overcharged by 10 times its actual use and continue to subsidize the suburban communities by over \$1.5 million dollars annually.

Left chart: GLWA's cancelled formula puts HP 3rd highest at 2.065% | Right chart: Actual flow data puts HP 8th at 0.21% | Difference: nearly 10 times more



Next steps are Highland Park will contact the GLWA Board and notify the State of Michigan.
