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# Capital Improvement Program Delivery

## RFP CS-272

### Status

- On July 27, 2018 GLWA advertised a solicitation for consulting services to enhance our CIP process and project delivery.
- Proposals were due on October 12, 2018.
- Two proposals were received.
- GLWA is currently in a “quiet” period evaluating submittals.
- It is expected that a contract will be brought to the Board of Directors for approval in January with an expected start date in February of 2019.

“ ...establish efficient enterprise-wide CIP business processes, provide standards/tools, and identify resource needs that will ultimately enable GLWA team members to manage a best-in-class CIP Program Management Office (PMO), independent of Vendor resources.”
