Since I led DWSD to arrange international symposia on water issues at American Chemical Society national meetings in Toronto, Washington, New York, I was particularly interested in GLWA proposed symposium on water analysis : from citizen scientists to laboratory breakthroughs at ACS national meeting in San Diego in August 2019. However, I was stunned by the title. Scientists work with volunteers to provide insight into water issues and this what is known as citizen science. Citizen science had demonstrated lack of proper sampling and analysis at GLWA.
