RE: Emergency Contract Number 1905101 “Northeast Water Treatment Plant High-Pressure Water System Emergency Partial Replacement”
Contractor: J.F. Cavanaugh Company

Please find below the response to the Board of Director’s request for the status of the above-mentioned Emergency Contract from the Operations and Resources Committee meeting of February 12, 2020.

Background: The high-pressure water system near the Northeast Water Treatment Plant is nearing failure and requires immediate design and reconstruction to not impair GLWA’s ability to provide clean water to the public. The equipment that needs replacing includes the hydropneumatics storage tank, piping, valves, pumps, local controls and appurtenances. The length of this contract is 610 days, with the contract final completion date of October 2, 2021. The total cost of this project is not to exceed \$3,000,000.00.

Status: The Notice of Intent was executed by J.F. Cavanaugh Company on January 31, 2020, thereby establishing an official start work date of January 31, 2020. The design work began on January 31, 2020, and the anticipated start date for the construction work is April 1, 2020. The project is proceeding as expected with no major issues to report at this time.
