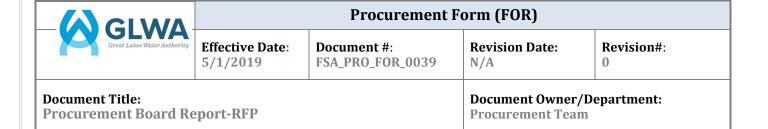

This level of effort is considered value added.
