Upon recommendation of David W. GLWA must acquire this easement, which is located on the property owned by Sharonville Enterprises, LLC. This property is needed for the Northwest Interceptor to Oakwood CSO Sewer project. Without this purchase agreement, GLWA cannot move forward with the project cost-effectively.
