JUSTIFICATION

This vacant property in Grand Blanc Township is no longer needed by Water Operations. Based on

information and belief, the neighboring property owner seeks to purchase the property for \$325,000. This is more than DWSD's purchase price in 2009 and is reasonable in consideration of a recent property appraisal. Pursuant to the Regional Water Supply System Lease and the Master Bond Ordinance, GLWA has the right to sell Leased Water Facilities that it no longer needs to support the service to wholesale customers.
