MOTION

Upon recommendation and opinion of Randal M. JUSTIFICATION

GLWA needs to acquire an access easement over property owned by Celani Family, LLC and located

at 24800 Haggerty Road. The access easement is needed in conjunction with the 14 Mile Loop Road Project, so that GLWA can access its facilities being constructed in the I-275 corridor from Grand River. Without an easement agreement, GLWA's ability to construct the 14 Mile Loop Road Project will be compromised.
