JUSTIFICATION

File #: 2020-462, Version: 1

GLWA needs to acquire permanent and temporary construction easements over property owned by Tom Holzer Ford, Inc. and CL, LLC and located at 39300 West Ten Mile Road. The easements are needed in conjunction with the 14 Mile Road Loop Project. Without an easement agreement, GLWA's ability to construct the 14 Mile Road Loop Project will be compromised.

BUDGET IMPACT

Easement acquisitions were included in the budget for the 14 Mile Road Loop Project.
