






# KEY PERFORMANCE INDICATORS -WATER






## KEY PERFORMANCE INDICATORS -WASTEWATER






### FY 25-29 PRE-ALIGNMENT FORECAST- WATER





# TASK 7 - WASTEWATER STAFF AUGMENTATION AND TECHNICAL SUPPORT

- Task limited to \$2.5M over 2 years following 3/19/2023.
- Spending will be allocated 60% to O&M and 40% to Capital Projects
- Wastewater Projects Only. Primarily Focused on 3 Projects
- Four dedicated Consultant Staff over 2 years.
