KPI WATER CUMULATIVE - FY 25



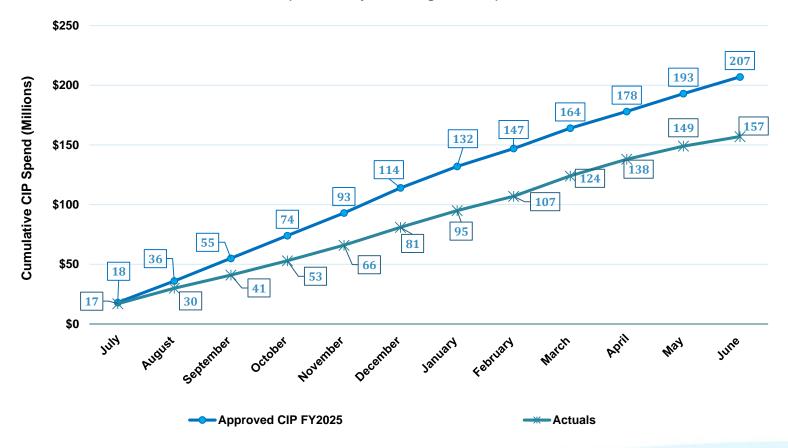
Cumulative Water CIP Activity FY 2025 Through June 30, 2025 (Preliminary as of Aug 4th, 2025)

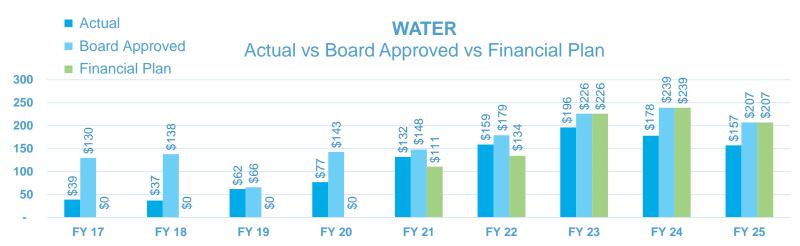

KPI WASTEWATER CUMULATIVE - FY 25

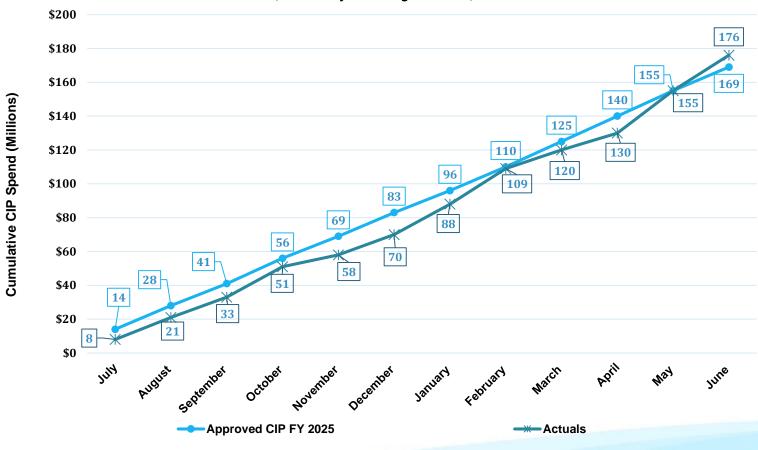


Cumulative Wastewater CIP Activity FY 2025 Through June 30, 2025 (Preliminary as of Aug 4th, 2025)

The wastewater system incurred \$176 million of CIP costs through June 2025. This is 104% of the FY 2025 Board *Approved CIP 2025-2029.*

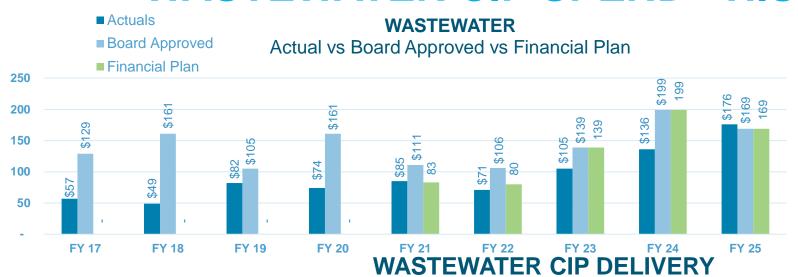

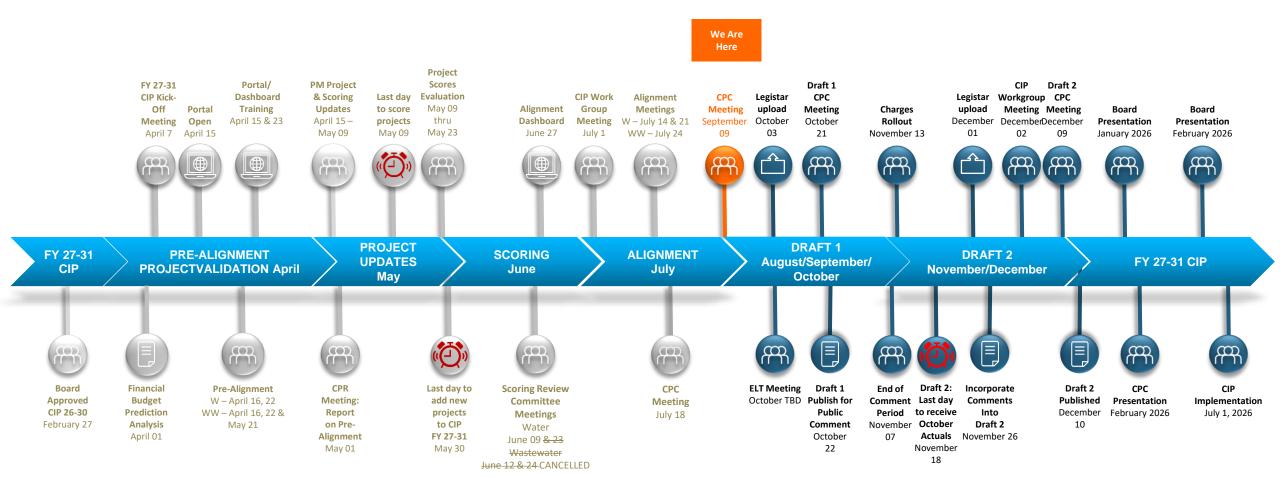

CIP FY 27-31 ROAD MAP





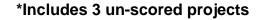


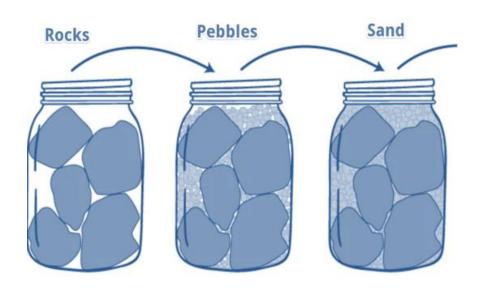

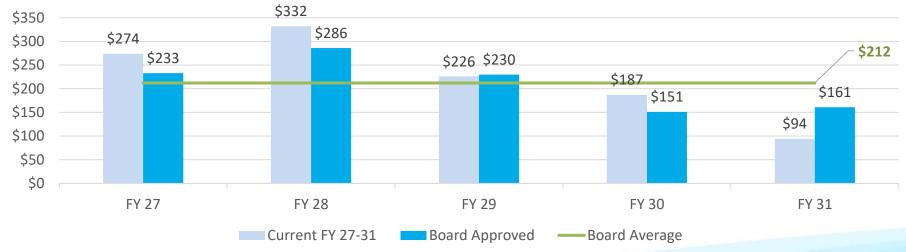

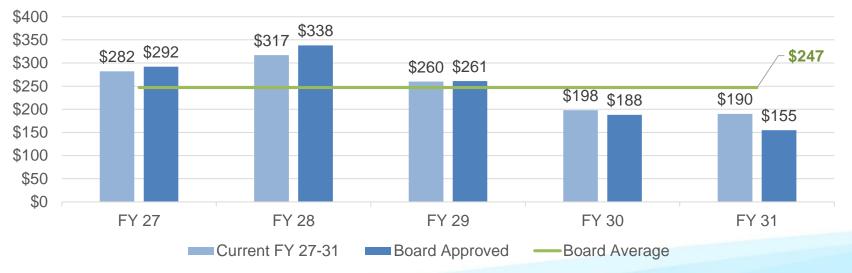

 - Phase 1 configuration to begin shortly

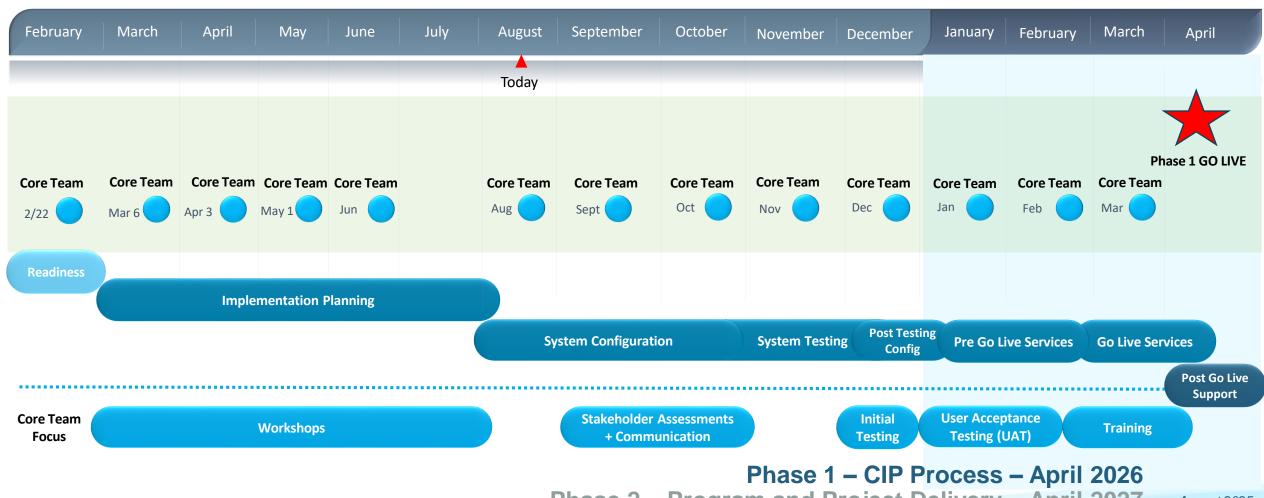




PMIS KAHUA SCHEDULE REVIEW - PHASE 1

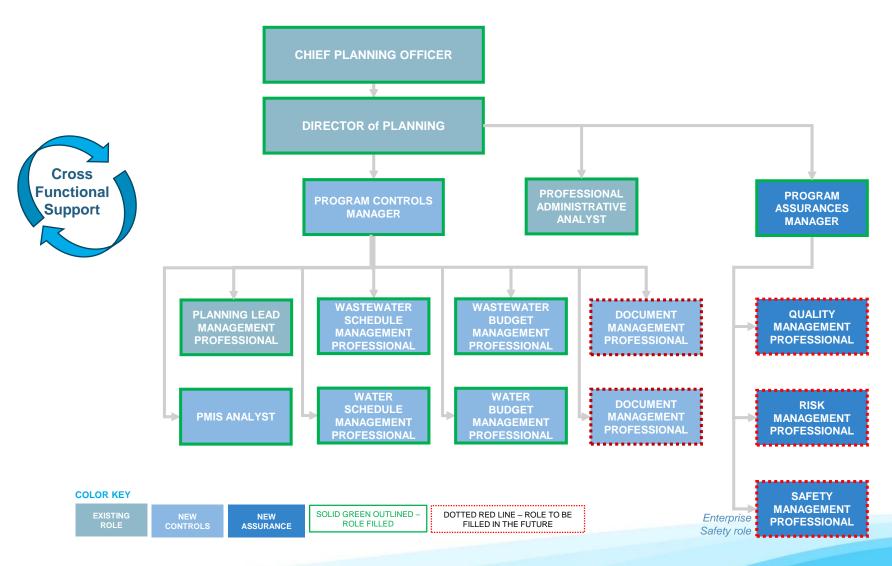

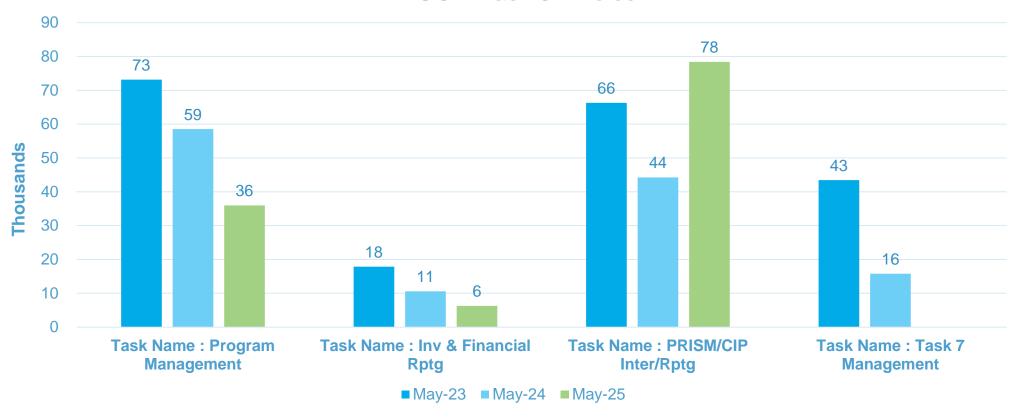
